

Tuesdays 6/25, 7/9, 7/16 & 7/23 @10am: Family Storytime Join us for stories, songs and messy art! Each week will have a different theme. Summer storytimes are for families with young children. Registration will be required each week and space is limited.

Wednesday July 17 & July 31st @11 am: Mystery Door Creative Writing Have you ever noticed that mysterious door near the ceiling in the junior area of the library and wondered why it's there and what could possibly be behind it? Do you enjoy making up stories and like to write? Using the mystery door as a prompt, come create an adventure story in this two-part workshop. In the first session we'll talk a bit about adventure stories and begin working on our stories. Writers will continue to work on their stories at home and return on the 31st to share with the group. This program is for kids entering grades 3-5 and registration is required.
